VILLAGE OF DENMARK SUMMARY


OWI ARRESTS IN DENMARK

DEO'S IN DENMARK

- DEOs continue to monitor parking issues around the village.
- DEOs have been working with the village to clean up some of the ordinances and also finding some ordinances that will help the village continue to be productive.
- DEOs continue to evaluate the specific enforcement needs of the village. Strategic plans and scheduling will allow us to continue to monitor problem areas as well as times of heightened problem rates in the village.







- 06-07-16 DEO Delebreau assisted CPS checking the welfare of a child.
- 06-08-16 DEO Dzekute attended a meeting with the Denmark School district safety committee. We discussed the school year and any issue that came up regarding safety issues.
- 06-09-16 The school zone signs were turned off for the summer. They will start functioning again the week before school starts just as a reminder to everyone that we will soon have kids in that area again. Even if the signs aren't functioning please use caution because we still have kids and adults that travel that area on foot.
- 06-09-16 Both DEOs attempted to pick up an active warrant in the village. No contact was made with the wanted subject.
- 06-10-16 DEO Dzekute responded to a fraud report. A resident had received a check in the male for a vehicle he was trying to sell on craigslist. After making some phone calls to the bank listed on the check and the company it came from it was found to be fraudulent.
- 06-12-16 DEO Dzekute was able to stop in at the All Saints picnic and check out the festivities. It was reported that DEO Delebreau had also been there undercover and posing as a customer. He was apparently testing the quality of the Booyah, and from the reports that have been heard it was very good.
- 06-14-16 DEO Delebreau responded to a fire alarm. It turned out to be someone cooking and the food boiled over.
- 06-14-16 through 06-16-16 DEO Dzekute attended the SRO Conference in Appleton. There were a number of excellent presenters and there was a lot learned that will help during the school year, but also when school is not in session.
- 06-17-16 DEO Delebreau found an open door at the Land O' Lakes building. The building was cleared with the assistance of one of Brown County's K9 officers.
- 06-21-16 DEO Delebreau addressed a hazard at the corner of CTH R and North Ave. He contacted the Brown County shops to cut the long grass on the corner that was creating an issue seeing the traffic.

SCAM report and things to watch out for

- We are starting to see an increase in thefts and burglaries throughout the county so continue to make your vehicles and houses hard targets. Lock your doors. Make sure valuables aren't left out for easy access. Most of the thefts and burglaries are "Stop and grab" crimes. The criminals tend to stop at the "easy targets" that they know they can get some property quickly and get away.
- Now that school is out there will be a lot more kids around. Please drive carefully through the village since they will be out walking, running, and riding bikes.
- With the warm weather and the increase in time we spend outside make sure you are taking in enough fluids, especially water. We see an increase in rescue calls related to the heat. Also make sure you protect your skin while outside. No one likes sunburn.
- We are still seeing a lot of scams involving calls claiming to be from the IRS. Do not give out any information to these calls.



- We are seeing scams involving calls stating a person has warrants or they will be picked up by the police for crimes. Don't give out any info to these callers. If you can't remember if you have anything in your past give either DEO a call and we can try to help you through this.
- We are also getting more scams involving calls stating the person has won a prize. As tempting as it might be to claim the "\$2.5 million prize" do not give out any information.
- A newer scam that is reemerging is coming from craigslist listings. Scammers are posting ads for houses, duplexes, or apt., that are available. The Scammer asks for money to be sent to them before the person has even seen the property. They will either give the excuse that you can't see the property or your meeting time will not work anymore to see the property. When renting or buying property make sure you see it before you buy it and remember there will always be some type of paperwork that goes along with it if it's legitimate.
- If anyone has a police matter that isn't an emergency but you would like an officer to come out please use the non-emergency number: 920-391-7450. This is the easiest way to either get the Denmark DEOs or if they are not available you will get an available county officer. If you have an issue that does not need immediate police attention you can continue to call the village hall and the message will get to us. Obviously if there is an emergency please call 911.
