## Effective January 1, 2016

### Charge: \$0.25/lb.

- Batteries, Household
- Computers & Electronics
- Cord Appliances
- Fire Extinguisher
- Florescent Lights
- Light, Ballast
- Adhesive, Water Based
- Caulk/Glaze/Grout/Putty
- Cement/Mortar/Plaster
- Latex Paint
- Antifreeze
- Windshield Wiper Fluid
- Cooking Oil/Grease

### Charge: \$1.00/unit

- Battery, Automotive (Lead Acid)

### Charge: \$5.00/unit

- Microwave

### Charge: \$15.00/unit

- Dehumidifier
- Miniature Refrigerator
- Small A/C Unit
- Small Water Cooler
